



High School Scholarship Application Information

The Scholarship

1. One \$1,000.00 scholarship will be awarded annually.
2. One \$1,000.00 scholarship will be awarded annually for a total of four years.
2. The winners of the scholarships will be announced at the Graduation exercises.
3. The awards will be paid to the winners only upon the completion of the fall term.

Eligibility

The applicant winner must:

1. Be a current graduate of Luseland School.
2. Express a sincere desire to further their education at any accredited technical or trade school or university.
3. The program that they enter must be of duration of at least one year.

Forfeiture of Scholarship

The individual scholarship winner(s) will forfeit any claim to the award by the following actions:

1. Failure to gain complete Grade 12 standing.
2. Failure to continue their education.
3. Failure to complete the first term of their indicated program by Dec 31 of the year of graduation.

Application Procedures

The Credit Union will provide the school with bulletin board announcements of the scholarships and the deadline dates. Luseland Credit Union will also mail a letter to each graduates home informing them of the scholarships and encourage them to apply.

The applicant must:

1. Indicate his/her desire to apply for the scholarships in a cover letter.
2. To the cover letter the following statements must be attached:
 - An official school statement of final Grade 10, Grade 11 and final first semester and second semester mid-term marks for Grade 12.
 - A written statement by the applicant that describes how they have demonstrated their “Concern for Community”, one of the seven guiding principles of the co-operative movement.
 - A statement of their involvement in school based extra-curricular activities.
 - A statement of their involvement in community, activities and/or outstanding effort in making future goals possible or in making our community a better place to live.
 - Two written references (One school based, and one other)
3. All applicants must complete the separate **Verification Form** and attach with application.
4. After completing the above, the applicant can personally drop off the application at the Credit Union or mail it to Manager, Luseland Credit Union Ltd, PO Box 518, Luseland SK SOL 2AO or email to **adam.franko@luselandcu.com**
5. Please save all online applications as: **FIRSTNAME_LASTNAME Scholarship Application**
6. Applications must be received by the Credit Union no later than **April 30th**, of the current year.

Award Criteria

A. The Luseland Credit Union Academic Scholarship

The following are the criteria that will be used to determine the award recipient. The weighting of each category is indicated.

1. Academic average based on the following subjects: English A, English B, Social Sciences 30, a Math 30 course, and a 30 level Applied Science (Chemistry, Biology Physics)70%
2. A written statement by the applicant that describes how they have demonstrated their “Concern for Community, one of the seven guiding principles of the co-operative movement15%
3. Involvement in extra-curricular activities.....10%
4. Written references5%

B. The Luseland Credit Union Victor J Delhommeau Scholarship

The following are the criteria that will be used to determine the award recipient. The weighting of each category is indicated.

- 1. Academic average based on the following subjects: English A, English B, Social Sciences 30 and any three other 30 level credits35%
- 2. A written statement by the applicant that describes why they have demonstrated their “Concern for Community”, one of the seven guiding principles of the co-operative movement.15%
- 3. Involvement in community activities and/or outstanding effort in making future goals possible or in making our community a better place to live40%
- 4. Written references10%

2. Please do not be modest. The Selection Committee will evaluate you based only on what is written on your application. Your answers must be neat and legible. Your essay must be typewritten and display proper essay format.
3. Carefully follow the instructions on each section of the application form. Complete all questions; enter “none” if no other response is appropriate. Do not leave any item blank.
4. Package together the completed application form, verification form, the certified copy of your marks, and two letters of reference. Deliver the application directly to Luseland Credit Union by **April 30th** of the current year.
5. The winning candidates will be announced during the graduation exercise.
6. The successful applicants will be asked to submit a grad photograph.
7. The scholarship winner will forfeit any claim to the award by any of the following actions:
 - a) Failure to gain a complete grade 12 standing.
 - b) Failure to complete the first term of their indicated program within one (1) year of graduation.
